The City of Oakland has been more responsive and helpful in resolving outstanding assessment fees of qualifying merchants.

Chris reports 97.78% occupancy rate on storefronts. We have very few empty storefronts. Market Hall is using old Alta Bates space for retail activities.

City approved granite for tree wells; this will be at their expense and not the RDA's.

Discussion on sidewalk repairs and logic behind which sections the City is tearing up and which ones they are not. DOT should stop work during the holiday season, but we will see.
