DANIEL SWAFFORD—WHO RUNS THE BIDS IN MONTCLAIR, LAUREL, AND (IN FORMATION) DIMOND—OFFERED HIS SERVICES TO EXPAND THE ACTIVITIES OF THE RDA BEGINNING WITH FACILITATING A STRATEGIC PLANNING PROCESS. AN EXAMPLE OF AN OPPORTUNITY TO DEVELOP FOR THE RDA IS FORMER DRYER'S BUILDING AND JEWISH COMMUNITY CENTER BUILDOUT—COULD INCLUDE AN EVENT SPACE WE COULD USE FOR MORE COMMUNITY AND CULTURAL ACTIVITIES TO ATTRACT MORE PEOPLE TO THE DISTRICT.

JODY MENTIONED DANIEL'S ABILITY TO FUNDRAISE/SECURE GRANTS FOR INITIAVES THAT SHE'S WORKED ON FOR DISTRICTS (AND GAVE THE EXAMPLE OF A STOPWASTE GRANT TO HELP RESTAURANTS IN THE LAUREL GO GREEN). SHE ALSO SAID THAT THERE IS LIKELY NOT MORE THAT SHE OR CHRIS CAN DO FOR THE RDA IN TERMS OF LARGER, STRATEGIC PROJECTS, IN SUPPORT OF CONSIDERING DANIEL'S OFFER.

VERONICA ASKED THAT WE CONSIDER THIS OFFER TOWARD THE END OF THE YEAR. INSTEAD, WE INVEST IN MORE SECURITY AND RAISES FOR CHRIS AND JODY.

NO VOTE WAS TAKEN.

LOUISE DISCUSSED THE FORMATION OF THE RDA.
