We did receive the final dispersement. We're in a good position cash wise. Conservatively we should end the year with a \$45,000 surplus (with lots of uncertainties). The PPP funds, big disbursements and reduced expenditures have led to this surplus. Anthony reports that we can safely allocate up to \$15,000 to any immediate needs/project.

After discussion about potential uses of such monies to promote the district the board unanimously decided to earmark the \$15,00 for two principal things: \$5,000 for grand reopening future event in the Spring & \$10,000 for whatever seems immediately appropriate between marketing and lighting. This includes the idea of a Lighting Grant program for storefronts.
